All Classes

Tots 1 - 3:

Designed for 3-5 year olds who have never skate before.

Beginner 1 - 2:

Designed for beginner's ages 6 - 14 that are just learning to skate. Level 1 covers forward skating skills. Level 2 covers backward skating and stopping.

Advanced Beginner 3 - 8:

Designed to teach more advanced maneuvers such as crossovers, spirals, basic spins and jumps.

Free Skate 1 - 6:

Designed to focus on advancement in jumps and spins as well as learning some of the ISI Moves in the Field skills.

Synchro Classes:

Synchro is held on Wednesday's at 5:20pm. It is a full 50-minute lesson. Skaters must have passed Basic 4 or Alpha. Must be proficient with crossovers.

Bridge Classes:

Designed for skaters who wish to learn at an accelerated pace. The classes are open to skaters in Alpha / Basic 4 thru Freeskate 4 levels. Class will have up to 5 - 6 skaters per instructor and a full 50-minute lesson. We are only able to have one class on Wednesday and 2 classes on Saturdays.

About Us

The New England Sports Center Learn to Skate offers a variety of programs. Classes for all ages and abilities are offered in recreational and competitive skating. We are a 5 ice rink facility, with a restaurant, snack bar, hockey pro shop, and fitness center. For more information please visit our website www.nes.com.

Additional Information

- Skates rental will be available as a courtesy on First Come, First Served basis with limited availability.
- Helmets are required for all beginners. Bicycle helmets are permitted.
- All classes and levels are offered on each day.
- Registration includes a yearly ISI membership or USFS membership. Cost \$20
- Pre-registration is required a week prior to secure the skater's place in class.
- NES reserves the right to cancel a session due to lack of enrollment.
- REFUNDS 100% before registration deadline, 75% after first week, no refunds after the second week. There are NO make up classes.
- Penalties: A \$35.00 penalty is assessed on all returned checks.
- Comfortable, flexible warm clothing. Dress in layers. Mittens or gloves recommended.
- Certificates are awarded to all skaters.
- Skaters are tested during the session.
- Figure Skates and Hockey skates are accepted. Plastic skates are highly discouraged. Double runners are not accepted.
